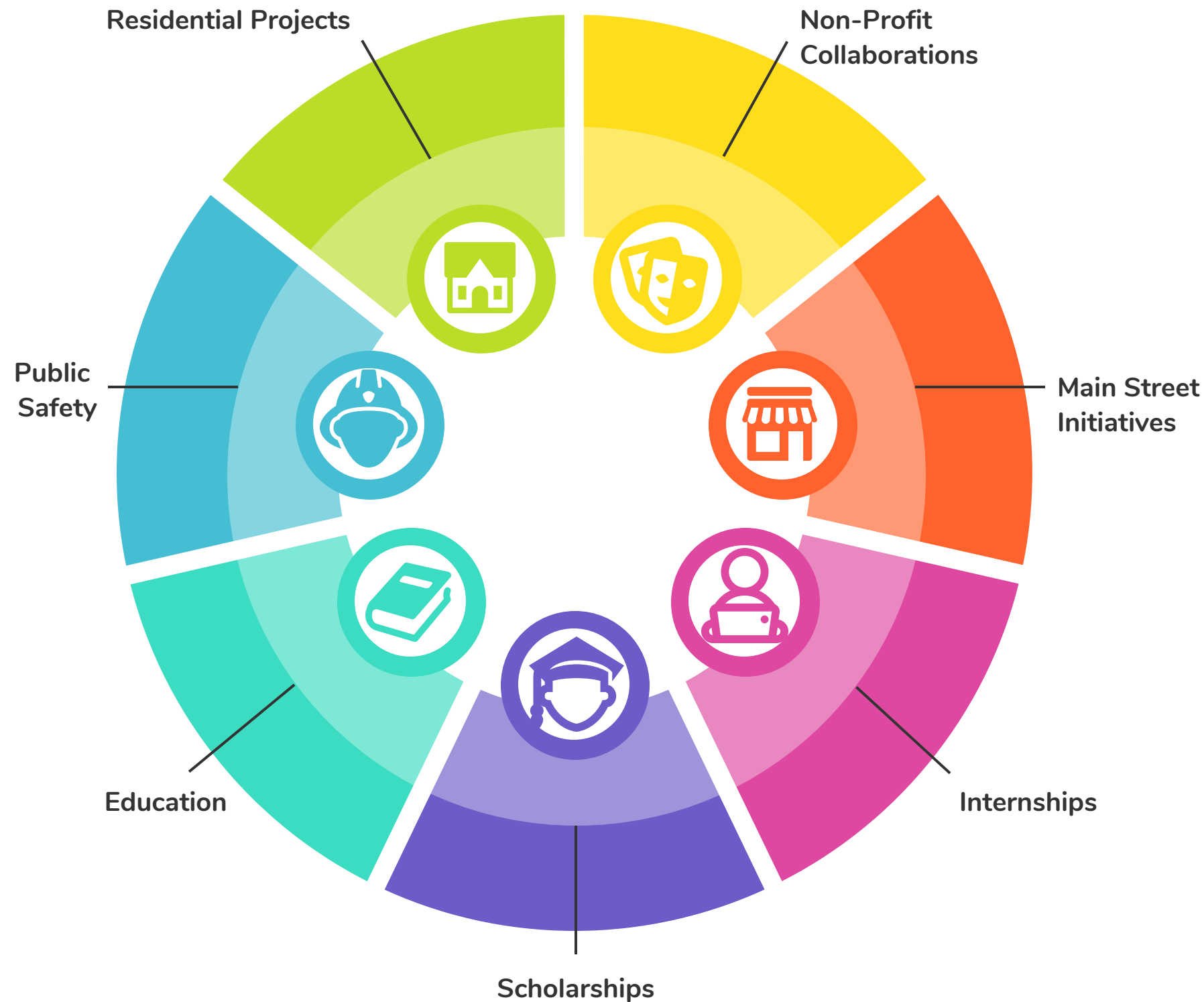


OpenCape Mission Driven Initiatives

● Non Profit Collaboration
